



Dripping Springs Theatre Booster Club Scholarship Program

Dripping Springs Theater Booster Club (DSTBC) will issue a maximum of three scholarships (with the total outlay to be \$1500.00) for the 2020-2021 graduating student members of the Dripping Springs High School Theatre Program. These scholarships will be based on theatre and school/ community participation and is not a financial aid scholarship.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must be a graduating Dripping Springs High School student, a current member of the theatre program, *and*:

- 1) Have completed at least one Level II (2) or higher Theatre or Technical Theatre class prior to current semester.
- 2) Participated in at least one DSHS theatrical production (to include auditions, after-school rehearsals, performances, tech work days, etc.)
- 3) Carry a current overall minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 or 75%.

Applicants must show evidence of intent to attend an institution of higher learning, and will be asked to explain how theatre has influenced their lives. *Applicants are NOT required to declare a theatre-related major for eligibility.*

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed application form, submitted by the May 7 deadline*, with all requested documentation attached. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- At least one letter of recommendation from a school source (teacher, counselor, administrator, etc.) and one from a source outside the school (employer, church, volunteer organization, etc.)
- A letter of acceptance, copy of the signature page of the admission application, or comparable documentation to demonstrate intent to attend an institution of higher learning. These may include universities, community colleges, or technical/trade schools.

***APPLICATION DEADLINE IS Friday, MAY 7 this year. If the deadline date falls on a weekend or other school holiday, the deadline will be extended to the following school day. All applications must be emailed to the DSTBC at dstheatreboosters@gmail.com by 5p.m. on the deadline date.**

SELECTION PROCESS

Applications will be reviewed and scored by a selection committee named by the DSTBC. Parents of graduating theatre students are not eligible to serve on this committee. Selection committee members will include, at a minimum:

- 1) One elected officer of the DSTBC
- 2) One representative from the school administration
- 3) One at-large parent representative

In addition to deadline and merit-related criteria, scoring will consider neatness and readability, spelling, grammar and punctuation. Ties will be broken, in order, by:

- 1) Highest average grade(s) in current theatre class(es); if this does not break the tie, then
- 2) Highest overall unweighted GPA; if this does not break tie, then
- 3) Scholarship money will be divided equally among tying applicants.

ANNOUNCEMENT AND PAYMENT

Recipient(s) will be announced at the DSHS Senior Awards ceremony. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the student at the discretion of the DSTBC with evidence of higher institution enrollment. The scholarship must be claimed by December of the year in which it was issued, or it will be forfeited.
